The adhesive biopsy and PLA test can help your doctor diagnose melanoma, the most deadly form of skin cancer, without the use of a scalpel. The PLA detects two genes which are elevated in melanoma skin cancer.

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Dear Patient,

DermTech performs a molecular pathology test for moles suspicious of melanoma, to obtain important information used in making decisions about your care and treatment.

DermTech will submit our laboratory claim to your insurance company on your behalf. It is likely that you will receive a written summary, called an Explanation of Benefits (EOB); from your insurance company which summarizes the payment status of this claim. **Please remember that an EOB is not a bill.**

Once your insurance company finalizes your claim, DermTech will send you a bill with your patient responsibility (for example: co-pays and deductibles as required). Any denied laboratory service will be appealed by DermTech on your behalf, with your insurance provider.

DermTech offers financial assistance to reduce out-of-pocket costs for qualified underinsured patients in the U.S. to no more than \$50. Examples of patients who are considered underinsured include:

- Those with a high deductible or out-of-pocket expenses.
- Those with non-medical coverage due to a restrictive medical policy.
