

one half unlike the other half.




BORDER

Irregular, scalloped or poorly defined border.



COLOR

Varied from one area to another; shades of tan & brown, black; sometimes white, red or blue.



DIAMETER

While melanomas are usually >6mm when diagnosed, they can be smaller.



EVOLVING

A mole or skin lesion that looks different from the rest or is changing in size shape or color.

HOW TO PERFORM A SKIN SELF EXAM

1

Examine your body in a full length mirror

Examine your body front and back in the mirror, then look at the right and left sides with your arms raised.

2

Look at your underarms, forearms, and hands

Bend your elbows and look carefully at your forearms, underarms, and hands.

3

Look at your legs, between toes, and feet

Look at the backs of your legs and feet, the spaces between your toes, and your feet.

4



Use a hand mirror to examine your neck and scalp

Examine the back of your neck and scalp with a hand mirror. Part your hair for a closer look.

5

Use a hand mirror to check your back and buttocks

Finally, check your back and buttocks with a hand mirror.
